In Case No. 2016-0253, Petition of Jeannette Marino, the court on June 7, 2016, issued the following order:

The court will treat Jeannette Marino's filing as a petition for original jurisdiction under Rule 11. Petition for original jurisdiction is accepted.

In accordance with RSA 7:6, a copy of this order and of Jeannette Marino's filing is being sent to the Attorney General.

This case appears to be eligible for mediation pursuant to Rule 12-A. Under Rule 12-A(2), the agreement of all parties is required for appellate mediation. If all parties in this case agree to participate in mediation, Jeannette Marino shall submit the completed Appellate Mediation Agreement form to the court on or before June 22, 2016. An Appellate Mediation Agreement form (NHJB-2614-SUP) is being provided to Jeannette Marino with this order. If an Appellate Mediation Agreement form is not filed, an order will be issued regarding further proceedings.
