7 MR. STEWART: And I don't know quite how to -- first
8 of all, there's a few hurdles here obviously, you know, the
9 reasonableness of the fees and things like that, Your Honor.
10 But just kind of thinking outside the box, I do know on the
11 accounting itself, there's other ways you can carry that money
12 over and make it part that of the estate. Call it a
13 contribution, something that was an inventoried if that money
14 -- it's kind of like somebody paid for a funeral and they paid
15 directly to the funeral parlor, you make it as a contribution
16 and you pay it back. I don't know that's a way if the Judge --
17 if you decide that she should be paid all of her fees, but that
18 is a way to include it in the estate, have her reopen it,
19 modify it, and earmark it, and run it through so to speak.
20 That's what I was thinking.

21 THE COURT: Okay. So you're talking about the
22 mechanics of it. I'm just looking just at the -- again, having
23 gone now through the file --
