It says James was appointed guardian over the person on April 18th.

MR. STEWART: Yes, and --

THE COURT: And Ms. Marino was appointed guardian over the estate on July 2nd.

MR. STEWART: May I approach, Your Honor --

THE COURT: Sure.

MR. STEWART: -- to show you? Here it is. This is -it says April 18th and it talks about maybe -- I had a cold
file I was looking at so I was trying to determine this this
morning. And in this July 2nd it dates back and then there's
clearly something in there from you appointing James over
person and Jeannette over estate, so I don't -- and a she's
starting work in May, correct? You did, that's what your
invoices show. So I just wanted to point that out. She's up
and running in May and then I have your order, then Judge
Hamby's. And there's actually a letter in May from Judge
Hamby. It's very inconsistent.

THE COURT: And that's the annual notice I think, right, is that --

MR. STEWART: Maybe. I can find it. I have it.

Okay. Ms. Marino has a complete set of the invoices if you'd like them, Your Honor. I mean, I don't know -- you can compare to what you have. Here we go.

Can I approach, Your Honor? I'll just show you.

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THE COURT: Sure.

MR. STEWART: This was the one I was looking at.

It's stamped -- this is and it says April 18th and then I was like, okay. And then I go back -
THE COURT: So it has Mr. as person -
MR. STEWART: And then it was -- I'm going to actually following it back up. I think this is part of that

actually following it back up. I think this is part of that and Jeannette is over estate, but then I have -- in May I have a letter from the Court asking Ms. Marino to serve.

THE COURT: Well, is it --

MR. STEWART: Bizarre.

THE COURT: Sorry to be talking about you and you're not in the conversation, but I have a motion from James Lazott that was filed in late April requesting that the Court appoint somebody to manage the estate. And Judge Hamby saying on May 15th that Jeannette Marino is appointed and set a bond, and then probably by the time, the bond came into issue some time had gone by. So there's a bunch of dates.

MR. STEWART: Yes. And this is a complete set.

MS. MARINO: Uh-huh.

THE COURT: And Judge Gordon approved the bond on June 28th. I think every judge in the system dealt with this at one point in time because Judge Macleod, who's out at superior court, had signed a few things in here too.
